## **JASON DUFNER**

JASON DUFNER: Yeah, a little up and down. Course is pretty scorable today. They have it set up pretty easy.

JASON DUFNER: Yeah, nice to get. Many been away from the game for a while. Couple months. Good to be out here competing. You know, I was playing pretty good. I just got to clean up some of the mistakes.

### **Q. Heading into tomorrow, do you have hopes of producing an awesome round?**
