## **VICTOR DUBUISSON**

### **Q. In the mix of things today.**

VICTOR DUBUISSON: Yeah, I played good, as yesterday, but all my putts don't want to go in.

It's this kind of day. Long game was really, really good, but didn't make any putts. I mean, I made few putts from like five feet, but between three and ten feet everything was lipping out. So disappointed in that.

I was like, Okay, this is not the day.

### **Q. How are you feeling? You were somewhat tired on arrival.**

VICTOR DUBUISSON: Yeah, I'm okay. I'm okay. I hope tomorrow will be a better day.

### **Q. Are you adapting, sleeping better after a couple days here?**

VICTOR DUBUISSON: Yeah. I need few more days, I think.

### **Q. What is your impression of this course now that you've had a chance to see it over two days?**

VICTOR DUBUISSON: It's very good. It's very technical course. You need to have a good strategy and place the ball on the right place on the green.

Yeah, it's a good course.
